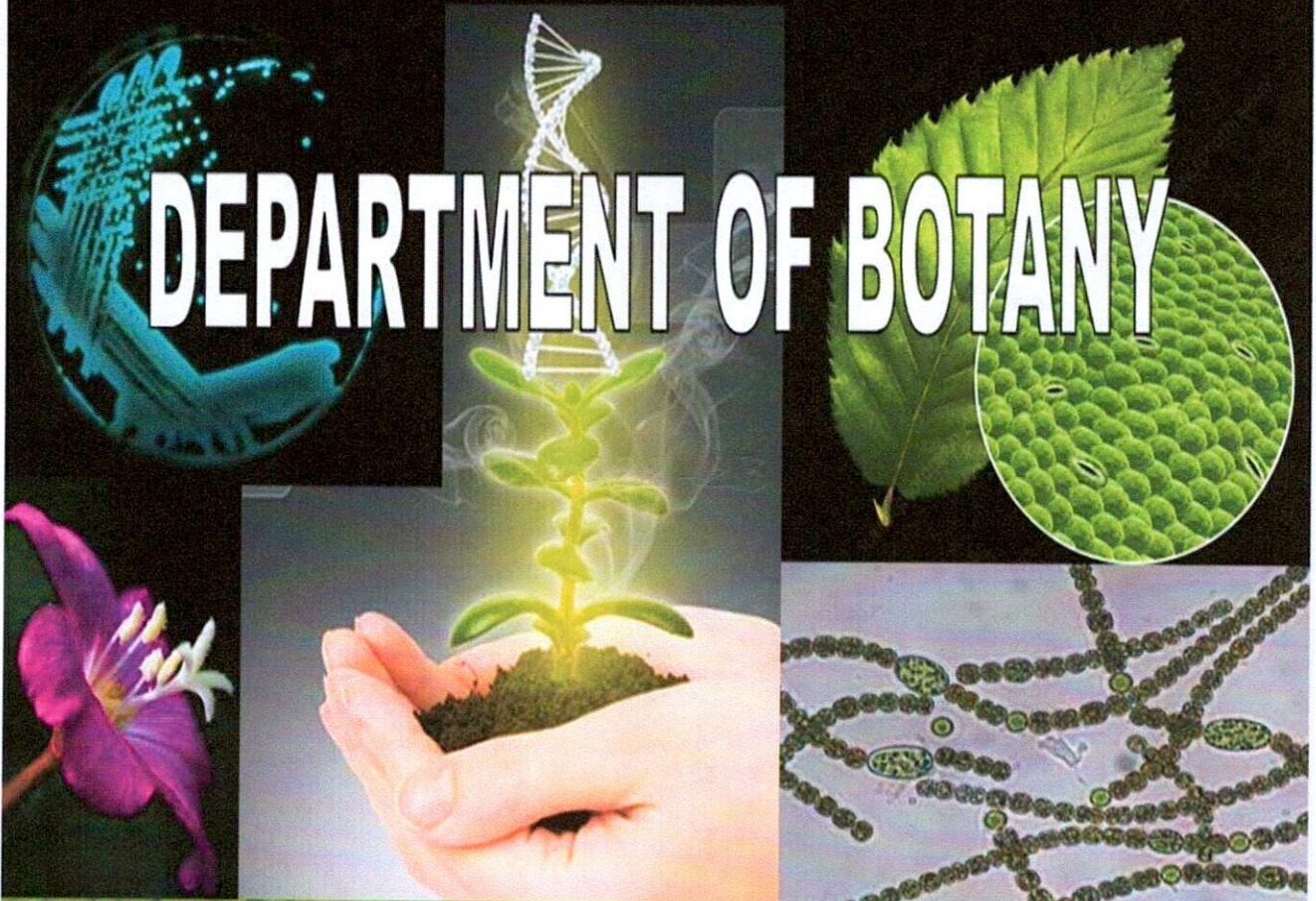

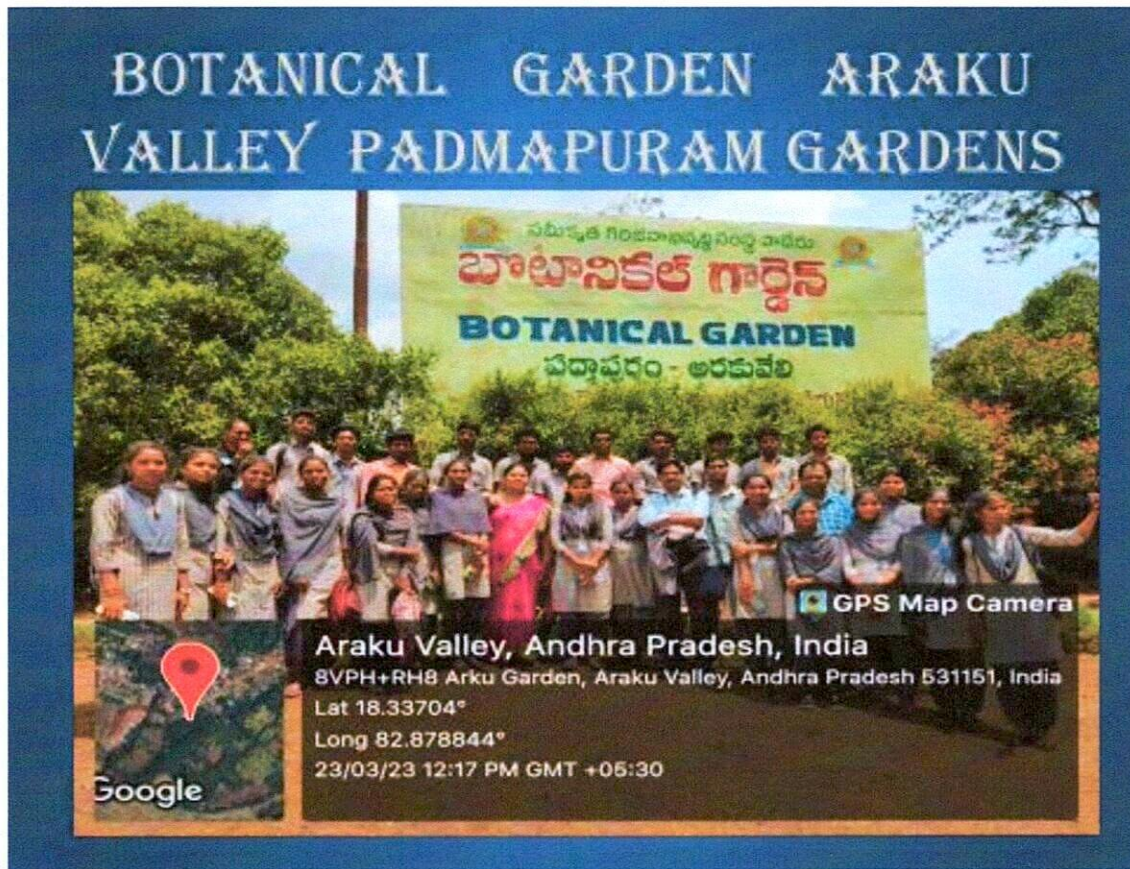

6. to study the phytographical distribution

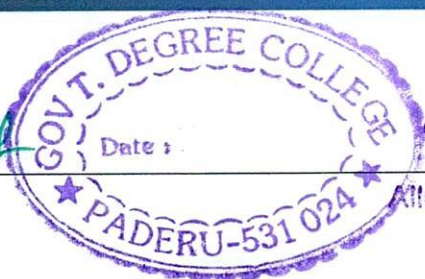

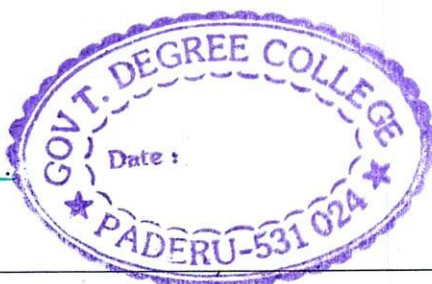
The tour was conducted by the faculty members of the department Dr.S.Chandra Kala, another faculty member P.Ramesh Kumar department of Zoology was joined the program also.
